1. Call Meeting to Order by Chairperson Nancy Johnson at 4:30 pm.

Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be held on Monday, March 23, 2015 at 4:30 p.m. at the Grant County Courthouse to consider an appeal filed with the Office of Planning & Zoning upon the decision of Planning & Zoning Administrator Krista Atyeo-Gortmaker's acceptance and recommendation of a Class A CAFO, by forwarding and placing on the agenda of the Board an application for a class A CAFO by Nelson Dairy.

Johnson explained the meeting was going to be turned over to State's Attorney Mark Reedstrom for the explanation of the procedure. Reedstrom explained the hearing notice went out showing that this was the time and place of the scheduled hearing for the appeal. The issue being brought before the board today is identical for all the appellants. It would be his position that he is providing legal counsel for the board that is based upon the moratorium.

The moratorium dated February 17<sup>th</sup> was lifted by the County Commissioners on March 17<sup>th</sup> which made the controversy that the appeal raised a moot point. The appeal stayed the CAFO hearing until it was heard as to whether Krista Atyeo-Gortmaker was in violation of the moratorium. Since that moratorium was rescinded that renders the appeal moot and there is nothing left for the board to decide regarding the issue on appeal.

No action was taken by the Planning & Zoning Board acting as the Board of Adjustment.
