- Be a resident of South Dakota
- Be under 21 years of age
- Have a <u>chronic medical condition</u> covered by Health KiCC.

# **Temporary Assistance for Needy Families**

It is designed to provide temporary assistance and economic self-sufficiency for children and families.

TANF is a needs-based program for families with children under age 18 (or under age 19 if the child is in high school) who need financial support because of: a death of a parent, a parent is absent from the home or physical or mental incapacity or unemployment of a parent.

Families with serious financial needs may qualify for TANF monthly cash payments. Your TANF payment is based on who lives with your family, who is eligible in your household, and other income and resources available to your family.

Medicaid (CHIP) provides quality health care coverage (including regular check-ups, Well-Child Care exams, dental and vision care) for children and youth. To be eligible for CHIP, children must be under the age of 19 and current residents of South Dakota.

Children who are uninsured or already have health insurance may be eligible for CHIP based on income and eligibility guidelines.

## **Home Weatherization Program**

A Program designed to help low income households overcome the high cost of energy, by making their homes more energy efficient. Labor and materials are provided.

- Services may include:
- Weather stripping doors and windows,
- Caulking & sealing cracks and holes
- Insulating attics, walls and under floors
- Repairing, tuning or replacing nonfunctional heating systems
- Incidental repairs necessary to protect the weatherization material.
