The Grant County Commission met in special session at 1 PM with Commissioners Buttke, Mach, Stengel, Street and Tostenson present. Chairman Tostenson called the meeting to order with a quorum present. Motion by Buttke and seconded by Stengel to approve the agenda. Motion carried 5-0.

Staff members present were P & Z Officer Steve Berkner and States Attorney Jackson Schwandt.

A discussion was held on reviewing the data needed, and how to obtain that data, when considering approving or denying a drainage permit application as found in our current Drainage Ordinance first approved in 1997. The Commission's discussion included reviewing Sections 101, 313, 317, and 318 of the current drainage ordinance and whether the current administrative form, and other information included in the draining permit application, was being used properly by the Drainage Board when considering drainage permits.

It is the policy of Grant County, South Dakota, not to discriminate against the handicapped in employment or the provision of service.

The next scheduled meeting dates will be August 31(special meeting), September 7 and 21, 2021, at 8 AM. Motion by Stengel and seconded by Mach to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 5-0. Meeting adjourned.
