The Grant County Commission met at 10:30 AM with Commissioners Buttke, Street, Stengel, Mach and Tostenson. Chairman Mach called the special meeting to order. The purpose of the special meeting is to consider a letter of support for the Flood Damage Repair and Erosion Prevention Project being submitted by the NRCS Office. Motion by Buttke and seconded by Stengel to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

Present was Krecia Leddy who explained the grant proposal and the area of the county selected for the proposed projects. The grant is seeking to bring in an additional \$480,787 to Grant County specifically targeting Twin Brooks, Grant Center, Stockholm, Madison Townships and twelve sections of Troy Township, landowners and producers. The proposal targets core conservation practices of water and sediment control basins, terraces, and grass waterways for gully erosion in the affected area due to the excessive rains from 2017-2019. Additional practices will be vegetative to establish cover to prevent erosion. Motion by Street and seconded by Buttke to authorize Chairman Tostenson to sign a letter of support for the grant application. Chairman Tostenson called for a roll call vote. Buttke aye, Street aye, Stengel, Mach aye and Tostenson aye. Motion carried 5-0.

It is the policy of Grant County, South Dakota, not to discriminate against the handicapped in employment or the provision of service.

The next scheduled meeting dates will be April 20 and May 4 and 18, 2021 at 8 AM. Motion by Stengel and seconded by Buttke to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 5-0. Meeting adjourned.
