Those that are exhibiting animals at Achievement Days, you will answer how many pens you need for your animals when you register on FairEntry. You will not be contacted by your Club Leader.

There will be an Achievement Day Help Session on Thursday, July 13 at 7:00-8:00 p.m. at the Grant County Courthouse Community Room. This evening will help families with registering on FairEntry, talking about different project classes, and filling out paperwork. Families are encouraged to bring any projects they would like to enter for Achievement Days. It doesn't matter if it's one item or a tote full.

This year, youth are eligible to take 10 static exhibits to SD State Fair, 10 animals and unlimited youth-inaction. There is a firm registration of Sunday, August 20 for State Fair instructions to register can be found in the Achievement Day Supplement Guide.

2017 4-H at State Fair: Pre-Preparation

Entry fees for 4-H members at the 2017 South Dakota State Fair have been sponsored for this year's State Fair. The 92nd South Dakota Legislative Session provided \$50,000 in allocated money to SDSU Extension's Youth Development Program for the sole purpose of eliminating or reducing fees for 4-H exhibitors and their families.

For the 2017 SD State Fair, there

will be an August 20 registration deadline for all entries (livestock, Youth-in-Action, and static).

All families must register their 4-H members in Fair Entry for up to 10 livestock entries and any Youth-in-Action events they want to participate in by August 20 regardless of ribbon placing.

Static exhibits must be entered by August 20. Each 4-H member may bring up to 10 static exhibit.

Animals may not be substituted after August 20th. The animals entered must be the ones exhibited.

The State Fair registration is currently open and will close August 20. This must be completed through Fair Entry, <u>https://fairentry.com/Fair/Signln/128</u> 7.

4-H Leaders provide Camp Fee Assistance

The SD 4-H Leader's Association will again assist with camp fees in 2015. There is a \$25 scholarship available for 4-H'ers who attend Camp Poinsett, Bob Marshall or North Central. There is a \$50 scholarship available for 4-H'ers who attend TLC or Performing Arts.

Here is how the scholarship program works.

• Step I – Register for the 2017

camp and pay the full camp fees.

- Step 2 Attend camp and have a great time!!
- Step 3 Tell a group about camp. For the \$25 4-H Camp scholarship, tell one group. For the \$50 TLC or Performing Arts Camp scholarship tell two groups.
- Step 4 Complete the camp assistance/scholarship application form with all

signatures and submit to the SD 4-H Leaders. You will receive your scholarship money within 2 weeks of its receipt.

The event will take place September 15-16 at the Animal Science Complex at the SDSU Campus in Brookings. For the 2017 SD 4-H Livestock youth-in-action contest, there is an August 1 registration deadline for all entries. Minor changes will be accepted until August 8.
