Members of the South Dakota 4-H Program, have the opportunity to apply for National 4-H Conference scheduled for March 28-April 2, 2020, in Chevy Chase, Maryland. Youth must be 16 – 18 years old by the date of the event to apply.

Conference Overview

The National 4-H Conference is a premier professional and leadership development event for

4-H members, ages 16 – 19, across the U.S. and its territories. The conference is administered by the National 4-H Headquarters of the National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA) within the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA). Held annually, except for several years during World War II, the camp's mission is to assist in the development of the next generation's leaders. Delegates attend training workshops,

become acquainted with government and have the opportunity to meet with state leaders.

Entry Fee - \$25 per calf entered. Pre-entry deadline -November 16th. Entries postmarked after the 16th, will be charged \$30 - No refunds!

Steers will be split by breed and then weight.

- Heifers are split by breed and then by age with fall heifers born in 2018 eligible to show per SDJPS rules. All other calves must be born in 2019.
- This show will be divided according to sanctioned rules.
 The British division is for British Straightbreds only.
- Registration papers/means to acquire papers are encouraged for all breeds or you are subject to show commercial.
- Calves entered <u>must</u> be accompanied by a <u>current health</u> certificate
- All exhibitors must check-in at 4-H Building on the Grounds before unloading trailers
- No washing facilities will be available
- All decisions of Show Committee and Judge will be final
- Calf Show Committee will not be responsible for accidents
- All bedding must be cleaned up or forfeit premium—a manure bunker is available on the south end of grounds
- Listen to KJAM (103.1) or KMIT (105.9) for cancellation information in case of bad weather. Updates will also be posted to the Miner County Feeder Calf Show Facebook page.
- Power is limited -- Portable generators advised
- Storm date December 7
- No pets allowed on grounds
